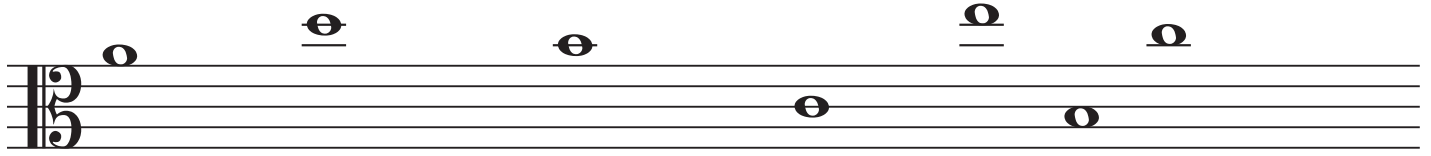
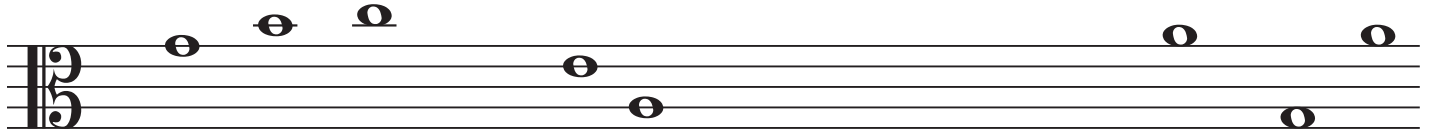

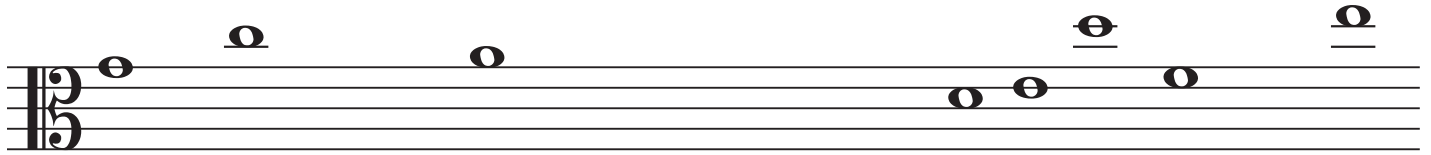
Antonin Dvořák was born in the Czech Republic in 1841 to



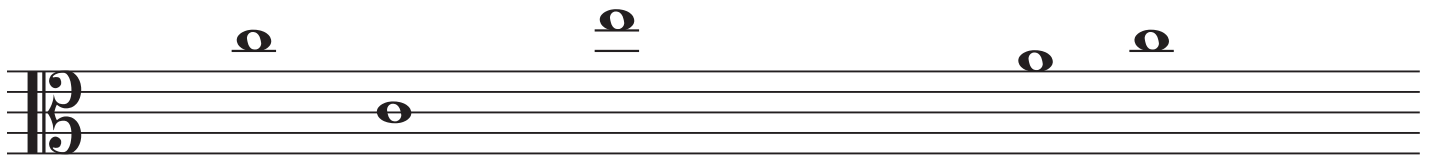
a village teacher. He learned to play the violin, viola, organ



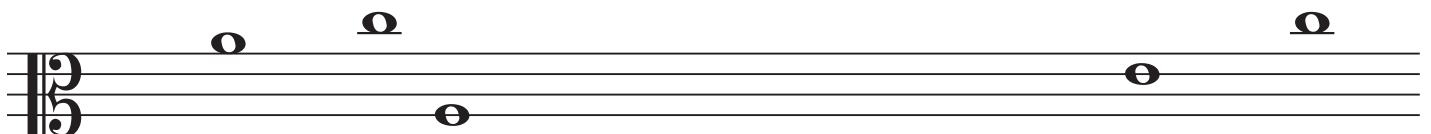
and piano and love to play folk dances. Dvořák
