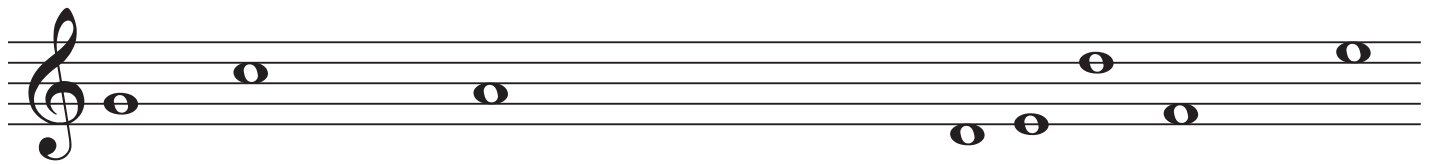
Antonin Dvorak was born in the Czech Republic in 1841 to



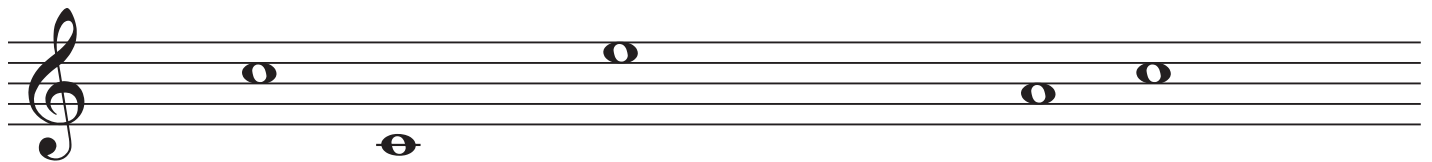
a village. He learned to play the violin, viola, or piano



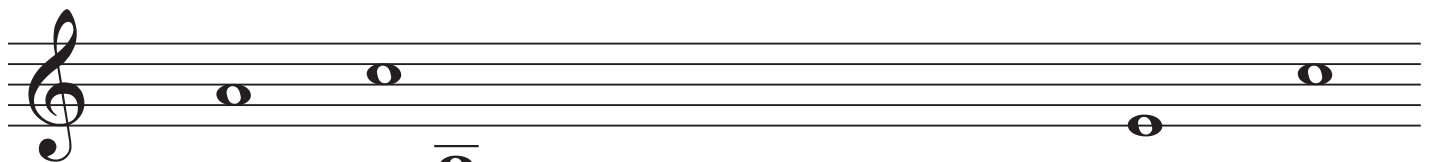
and piano and love to play the violin, viola, or piano
