

Online Violin Lesson Student Checklist

High-Speed Internet

- To ensure that the picture and sound are not interrupted during your lesson, limit streaming and gaming from other devices in your house.

Camera for Video Chat

- A phone tablet or computer will work. If using a phone place the phone camera on a stand or table so that it is stable. It's best not to place it on the same music stand you are using for your music.

Video Chatting Software

- Discuss with your teacher about what video chatting software, Skype, Facetime, Google Hangouts, Zoom, you will use for your lesson.
- Let your teacher know your username.

Quiet Room

- Choose a room in your house that is free from distraction..

Instrument and Music Stand

- Set up the music stand to the left side of your phone or computer screen. This will allow the teacher to see your fingers and bow hand.

Pencil and Paper

- Be ready to write down assignments. And make notes and markings in your music.

Music

- Collect all the music you need for your lesson before your lesson starts.

Parents should attend online lessons.

- For students whose parents attend their in-person lessons, they should also be present for online lesson and take notes during the lesson.
