

## Parents' Guide to Beginning Rhythm Reading

Note	Note name	How to clap rhythm names	Beats	How to clap beats
J	Quarter Note	"Quarter" clap 1 time	1	Clap on 1
9	Half Note	"Half-Note" clap on "half" and hold hands together	2	Clap on 1 – hold hands together on 2
<b>d</b> .	Dotted Half Note	"Half-note-dot"  Clap on "half" and hold hands while saying "note-dot"	3	Clap on 1 – hold hands together for 2, 3
o	Whole Note	"whole-note-four-beats" whole-note-four- beats"  Clap on "whole" and hold hands while saying "note-four-beats"	4	Clap on 1 and hold hands together for 2, 3, 4
